EMERGENCY ORDER 20-24

SUBJECT: PHASE 4 OPERATING GUIDELINES FOR BARS AND RESTAURANTS CONCERNING SEATED OCCUPANCY AND SOCIAL DISTANCING AND FACE COVERINGS

EFFECTIVE DATE: August 19, 2020

EFFECTIVE TIME: 5:00 P.M.

DURATION: Until the date of the termination of the Emergency Ordinance 2020-022 or as modified or terminated by the Mayor or the City Council.

The Mayor, upon recommendation of the City Manager and pursuant to Council Bill 2020-022 and Section 12-39 of the Champaign Municipal Code hereby orders as follows for all establishments holding a City of Champaign license to sell alcoholic liquor ("liquor establishments") located within the City of Champaign:

1. **State Phase 4 Guidelines Applicable.** All liquor establishments located within the City of Champaign licensed for the retail sale of alcohol liquor for consumption on the premises shall comply with the COVID-19 2020 Restaurant and Bar Establishment Safety Guidelines for Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois Plan (the "Guidelines"), as issued by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity. Said Guidelines, attached as Exhibit 1 hereto, are incorporated into this Order, and any violation of the Guidelines shall be considered a violation of this Order. In the event of conflict between the Guidelines and this order, this order shall prevail.
2. **State Face Covering Rules Applicable.** All liquor establishments shall comply with the Illinois Department of Public Health Emergency Rules to Enforce the Use of Face Coverings, attached here as Exhibit 2 (the "Emergency Rules"). Said Emergency Rules, are incorporated into this Order, and any violation of the Emergency Rules shall be considered a violation of this Order. In the event of conflict between the Emergency Rules and this order, this order shall prevail.
3. **Face Covering By Patrons.** In compliance with the Illinois Department of Public Health Emergency Rules, Champaign-Urbana Public Health District Ordinance 2020-08-05, and Emergency Order 20-26, all patrons must wear masks or face coverings, covering the nose and mouth of the patron, when not eating or drinking.
4. **Patrons Must be Seated.** The sale, service, and consumption of alcoholic liquor on the premises shall be allowed for seated patrons only. Standing area occupancy shall not be allowed, either in indoor or outdoor service areas.
5. **All Patrons to be Seated** All patrons present in the establishment must have a seat in the establishment, whether a chair, booth, picnic-style table, or bar stool, and must remain seated except for the limited and temporary purposes described in paragraph 6.
6. **Exceptions to Seating; Face Covering Required While Standing.** Patrons may stand only for limited purposes, including using the restroom, placing an order at a designated service area, picking up an order for carry out, or to enter or exit the
