



establishment. These limited purposes do not include eating or drinking. No more than two (2) patrons may stand to use any individual arcade game, dart board, pool table, or similar bar game or entertainment device at a time. Patrons must return to their seats when their use of the game concludes. Any patron that is standing must be wearing a face covering over the nose and mouth.

7. **Enforcement: Security Cameras.** Pursuant to the investigation of a specific complaint, or upon the observation or reasonable belief of any enforcement officer or official that an unsafe or unsanitary environment exists or recently existed, any liquor establishment must provide immediate and unrestricted access to footage from its security camera systems upon request by the Champaign Police or Fire Department, or by any authorized agent of the City of Champaign Liquor Commissioner’s Office, or Champaign-Urbana Public Health District.
8. **Entry Age.** Effective beginning at 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday August 19, 2020, the entry age for all liquor establishments holding a Class A license shall be 21 and over after 9:00 p.m. each day. Licensees must cause any patrons under the age of 21 to leave the premises at such time.
9. **Violation: Penalty.** A violation of this Order shall be considered and administered as a violation of the Champaign Municipal Code. Any person or entity in violation of this Order shall be subject to the penalty provisions contained in Chapter 5 and Section 1-21 of the Champaign Municipal Code providing for a fine of up to \$750 per day.
10. **Requirement for Licensee Enforcement of Standards; Notice to Patrons.** The person holding the liquor license for a premise shall be responsible for enforcement of the standards set forth in this ordinance. The Licensee shall prominently post such requirements regarding seating and face coverings at the entrance to each liquor establishment and upon any table for the seating of patrons.
11. **Code in Effect.** All other sections of the Champaign Municipal Code not in conflict with this order, including but not limited to Chapter 5, remain in full force and effect, and are made applicable to this Order.
12. **Duration.** This Order shall be in effect until the termination of Emergency Ordinance 2020-022 or as modified or terminated by the Mayor or City Council.
13. **Repeal.** Emergency Order 2020-21 is hereby repealed and replaced with this Emergency Order 2020-24.
